

6.1 Dress Code

The uniform is designed to foster a sense of unity and identity among our students. By adhering to the dress code, we create an inclusive and focused learning environment. Wearing the school's uniform during the school day is mandatory, and students are expected to wear the approved school uniform with pride, ensuring it is clean, neat, and properly fitted at all times.

Students are encouraged to wear the official school jackets or coats. However, any weather-appropriate outerwear in neutral colours is also permitted. Footwear should be safe and appropriate for a school environment.

Grooming and personal hygiene are important, including clean and well-kept hair, trimmed nails, and minimal use of strong fragrances. Extreme hairstyles and makeup must be avoided.

Teachers and staff members have the duty of ensuring students adhere to the uniform policy. In case of any violations, appropriate measures, such as reminders, temporary restrictions, or other disciplinary actions, will be taken to address the situation.

In the event of a student not complying with the uniform policy, consequences may include the child being sent home to change into the correct uniform. This measure is taken to reinforce the importance of adhering to the school's uniform guidelines and to

maintain a consistent and respectful appearance throughout the school community. The absence resulting from this will be considered “unexcused.” Final decisions about the “appropriateness” of dress are made by the school.

The uniform policy may be reviewed periodically based on feedback from students, parents, and staff. Any changes or modifications will be communicated to the school community in a timely manner.
